FAAMAI 360 Mapping Competition 2020

FAAMAI DIGITAL ART HUB invites high school and university students to participate in the FAAMAI 360 MAPPING COMPETITION 2020 for the opportunity to win scholarships, certificates and join a Creative Coding Workshop.

Submit an online application from the official website: https://360mappingcompetition.com/ by 12 November 2020. (Extend to 24 November 2020.)

Contest topic:

Creative Coding (Beginners are welcome to submit their processing work) Workshop available on 31 October to 1 November 2020 (Participants can submit their work before joining the workshop)

Application period:

28 September to 12 November 2020 (Extend the deadline to November 24, 2020)

Theme: "New World"

Contest Categories:

University students and youths not over 25 years old

Category 1: Coding - Beginner Level Category 2: Coding - Advanced Level

Participant qualification:

- 1. Student participants are required to have student status at any university. Professional participants are required to be under 25 years old and of any ethnic background or nationality.
- 2. Participants can apply as individuals or as teams (not exceeding 10 people per team) as long as they meet the requirements.

Requirements:

- Applicants need to complete an online application form and clearly provide information about the category they are applying for. If applying as team, they have state to the number of team members and the first & last names of all team members. Applicants can submit an online application on the official website. https://360mappingcompetition.com/
- 2. Applicants need to summit their Processing files in PDE format along with video clips (not over 1 minute in duration) to verify their work. They also have to specify full name and contact details. Applicants need to display their first and last names in white font on black background for 5 seconds prior to the 60 second clip of their work.
- 3. Minimum resolution must be 3740 x 1200 pixels.
- 4. Applicants need to describe the concept and background of their work on one (1) A4 page (including references).

- 5. One (1) team can submit a maximum of two (2) works.
- Submitted digital art works will be displayed on the exterior surface of the FAAMAI DIGITAL ART DOME and displayed via Facebook: FAAMAI Digital Arts Hub on 20 November 2020. (change to 27 November 2020.)

Contest Guidelines:

1. Use Processing as the main tool to create your digital art works. Applicants can create an entire work via Processing or include parts created by other tools (drawing, Photoshop, Illustrator etc.). The contents must not violate copyright law (Applicants are recommended to create their own content). However, the judging criteria will focus on creativity in coding, first and foremost.

2. First Round

- Finalists selected by expert committee based on aesthetics, compliance with ethics/copyright law and understanding of processing.
- Committee may contact applicants via phone call or Zoom for inquiries.

3. Final Round

- The finalists' works will be displayed on half of the external surface of FAAMAI DIGITAL ART DOME.
- Expert committee to decide the winner with reference to Applicants' interpretation of the "New World" theme.

Contest process:

- Submit online applications and digital art works during 28 September to 12 November 2020 at https://360mappingcompetition.com/. (Extend the deadline to November 24, 2020)
- 2. Submit digital art works by 28 September to 12 November 23:59hrs (Bangkok time). (Extend the deadline to November 24, 2020) Announcement of successful candidates on 19 November 2020. (Date TBC) Submitted digital art works will be displayed on the exterior of the dome at FAAMAI DIGITAL ART HUB and displayed via Facebook: FAAMAI Digital Arts Hub on 20 November 2020. (change to 27 November 2020.)
- 3. Candidates' works will be displayed via Facebook: FAAMAI Digital Arts Hub so that the public can vote to determine the most popular artwork, between 21 and 23 November 2020. (change to 28-30 November 2020.) Voting period ends at 23:59h on 23 November 2020. (change to 30 November 2020.)
- 4. Award ceremony will be held in December 2020 (time and place TBC).
